### DR. DANIEL SEEKS STRATEGIC PLANS FOR FUTURE OF UTD

At the April Staff Council meeting, the representatives discussed the meetings on Strategic Planning that are currently taking place on campus. These meetings are at the request of Dr. David Daniel who will assume the roll of UTD President on June 1<sup>st</sup>. Dr. Nelsen, Speaker of the Faculty presented the following list of discussion items on the Campus Life agenda in order to encourage our thinking about staff involvement in this process. District representatives were asked to submitt their thoughts and ideas for the strategic plan.

#### CAMPUS LIFE DISCUSSION ITEMS

- Mixed use development of the land around UTD (defining the campus perimeter)
- Grounds (beautification, recreation, etc.)
- Infrastructure (classrooms, sidewalks, building maintenance, etc.)
- VP or Vice Provost for Diversity
- Ombudsman (for students only? for faculty and staff too? two people?)
- Housing (dorms? apts.? family housing?)
- The creation of living learning centers
- Service learning and experiential learning
- Need based financial aid (graduate and undergraduate)
- Undergraduate recruitment of top 10 percent (e.g., Sci-Tech Development Center and other science outreach programs)
- Improved persistence rate for students, especially minority students
- Student placement (role of Career Center, schools, etc.)
- Role of sports (division II? additional sports? scholarship vs. non-scholarship)
- Greek life (residential vs. non-residential)
- Graduate and undergraduate student satisfaction
- Graduate admissions
- Graduate recruitment (stipends, packages, etc.)
- Graduate research engine to promote opportunities
- Web enhancement
- Community outreach (e.g., global epidemic exhibit, Science Place, Dallas Museum of Art projects, science and math in the local schools, industry involvement in modeling labs)
- Continuing education (on the professional level, especially towards certification, or in-fill programs)
