

# Update on Campus Parking

Joyce Crum, along with University Administration, the Parking & Security Committee and the City of Richardson, are working with an outside firm to plan for future parking and vehicular traffic. Some innovations being discussed are:

- Limiting vehicular traffic in the center of campus by use of access gates that require security cards
- Finishing Armstrong Parkway to connect with University Parkway
- A parking lot across from the School of Management on the northeast corner where Drives A & G cross
- A lot north of the Multi-Purpose/ Administration Building
- A main belt road around the campus incorporating existing and newly constructed roads
- A possible deal with the City of Richardson allowing them to lease space south of the existing soccer fields for development as athletic/ recreation fields in exhange for assistance in building main belt road around the campus

# DID YOU KNOW ...

That you can change your voice mail greeting at work from any phone? This is convenient if you are ill and need to change your greeting from home. Follow these steps to change your message:

- While logged into your mailbox, press 82.
- Then, press 1 for external greeting, press 2 for internal greeting, or press 3 for temporary greeting.
- Press 5 to record your greeting. Wait for the tone, then record your greeting.
- Press # to end your recording.
- Press 2 to play/review your greeting.
  For a Temporary Greeting: Press 9 to set expiring date and time. The system will prompt you as to the information needed.
- Press 4 to return to your messages or Press 83 to log off.

# PROJECT QUEST "BANNER PROJECT" STATUS UPDATE

On January 18, 2006, President David Daniel authored a letter to UTD stating the project has been delayed by approximately 90 days while UT System evaluates potential cost savings and efficiencies that may accrue by coordinating our efforts with other UT System institutions, including UT Arlington and UT Tyler. This pause will necessitate a delay in the scheduled go-live date of September 2006 for the financial package by at least one year. Dr. Daniel has thanked the staff for ther cooperation and promised to keep them informed as more is learned.
