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It's Election Time!


The Staff Council is now conducting elections and appointments for the 2011-2013 term. The elections are conducted on a district-by-district basis.

PEOPLESOFT CONCERNS

A message from your Staff Council Executive Board

On May 23, 2011, the Staff Council Executive Board met with Dr. Daniel to address staff concerns regarding the PeopleSoft implementation. Our intention in meeting with him was to make sure he was aware of concerns directly from the staff perspective. Prior to this meeting, we solicited emails from staff regarding any issues they might be experiencing surrounding the new system. We received a good response and summarized these for Dr. Daniel. Our summary revealed several key areas of concern, which we presented to Dr. Daniel, along with some recommended solutions for discussion and review. These included:

- Communications generally, staff have felt that communication regarding
 the status of the system and any issue resolution has been relatively nonexistent for most staff members. We have advocated for regular email
 updates and/or some kind of "issue board" where staff can get relevant
 information and updates.
- False Expectations related to communication, but also in regard to response time on issues and lack of access to information. We have advocated for all staff to be granted the access they need to various screens in PeopleSoft to get day-to-day work done, especially with regard to HR and financial areas.
- Training general staff training, especially early on, focused on the functionality of the system with no real insight into the system and how it would work related to how we currently function. Staff have expressed the desire to learn and we have advocated for improved training using real examples. The general consensus was that the training provided regarding the SciQuest system was a good model to replicate.
- **Cost** in terms of loss of productivity, impact on health/morale, as well as issues with incorrect paychecks. Staff have expressed a willingness to help make things better, but they don't know how. We have advocated for staff to be more involved in the overall process as much as possible.

Dr. Daniel appreciated the meeting and was going to look into the issues we presented. We will have a follow-up meeting with him soon and we'd like to report on any progress, or lack thereof, related to the above areas or other areas that might be problematic. 
The Parking and Transportation Committee is a University wide committee that meets the 2nd Wednesday of each month. The committee consists of faculty, staff, and student representation who make suggestions and prepare proposals to submit to the Office of Business Affairs for approval.

Some of the issues/milestones/projects which the Parking & Transportation Committee members are currently working on include*:

- Online parking decal purchase/payroll deduction will be in-house in FY2012.
- Violation citation fees will increase.
- Campus parking decal prices will increase.
- DART passes for students cost will increase to ~\$11 year.
- DART passes for faculty/staff cost will increase to ~\$312 year.
- Parking & Transportation Committee will renew contract with Buses by Bill.
- Parking & Transportation Committee will update their website.
- Parking & Transportation Committee will develop an educational video.
- A new combo Gold/Green Housing/Campus parking decal will be introduced.
- Zip Car fuel efficient car rentals will be available on campus. Hourly/Daily/Weekly rates.

Summer Exercise Tips from your UT Dallas Wellness Committee

Over the last 20 years, more people in the US have died from extreme heat than from hurricanes, lightening, tornadoes, floods, & earthquakes combined. (Center for Disease Control and Prevention)

- Allow for Acclimation. Cut back on time & intensity of your workout until you've acclimated to the high temperature.
- Exercise in the morning or evening. Avoid exercise from 10-3 when temperatures are at their highest.
- Dress for the heat. Minimal, loose fitting clothing in light colors is best. Avoid 100% cotton. A wicking material is best.
- Drink up. Make sure to drink plenty of water before, during & after exercise. Minimize soda & coffee.
- Know when to stop. Symptoms of heat exhaustion include fatigue, dizziness, nausea or vomiting, headache, rapid heart beat, confusion or complete loss consciousness. Stop activity immediately if you experience any of these symptoms.
