Green Zone Training

I recently had the pleasure of attending my second Green Zone training. Over the past few years, it has developed into an engaging program with ample opportunities to learn and connect. The Military and Veteran Center (MVC) hosts Green Zone training to help staff and faculty better serve veteran and military-affiliated students. The goal is establishing a University-wide network of staff and faculty who shape a military-friendly campus culture. The program educates participants about the different branches of the military, their ranking systems and terminology, as well as compare this environment to a civilian or student's life. Participants gain a greater understanding of service members' experiences and the challenges they face as they transition out of the military.

Lisa Adams, director of the MVC and an Air Force veteran, is earning her doctorate in higher education. Adams advocates for veterans and military-affiliated students, offering insight into their experiences. She is devoted to making a difference in the lives of these Comets, ensuring they have the necessary resources to succeed at UTD and in their careers.

Compared to traditional students, veterans and military-affiliated students often are more mature and focused to do well in school, thanks to their various life experiences. In addition to learning how to navigate UTD after many years away from school, many of them also have complex family and financial responsibilities, and have emotional or physical challenges that are not always visible.

During Green Zone training, faculty and staff discuss and learn ways to address veterans and military-affiliated students' needs to help them achieve their mission of

graduating. We were presented with helpful suggestions in addressing students directly. And while it's natural to be curious about their military experiences, it is not appropriate to ask about their service unless they choose to engage in that discussion. They have more than one aspect of their identity and many interests outside of military. Many are proud of their service, but they are also trying to move on to the next chapter of their lives.

Peer Advisors for Veteran Education (PAVE) is a peer support program which pairs new student veterans with peer advisors. PAVE students discussed how they are trying to support students within their degrees to find and use the tools they need to be successful.

The training ended with attendees eating military field rations, known as MRE or meals ready to eat, for lunch and a question-and-answer panel with students. The group seemed to enjoy learning how to heat up the meals. The students were engaging and very open about answering questions.

I definitely encourage every staff and faculty member to attend Green Zone. It gives a lot of insight into the population that we serve and provides the tools to help succeed. You learn a lot and feel connected to an important group of students.

At this time, the Military and Veteran Center is limiting Green Zone training to staff and faculty. Upon completion, participants are given a certificate and a Green Zone decal for their office.

The training includes lunch. Please register or get on the waiting list for the next Green Zone training, which should be in October.
