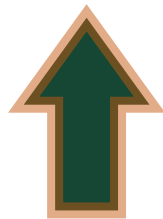

 - Features Dietitian Carly to help students focus on mindful eating

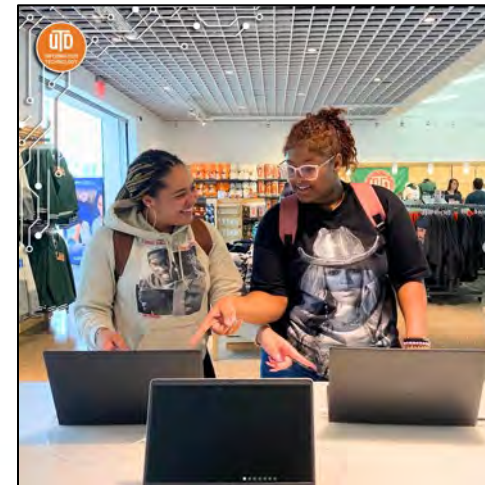

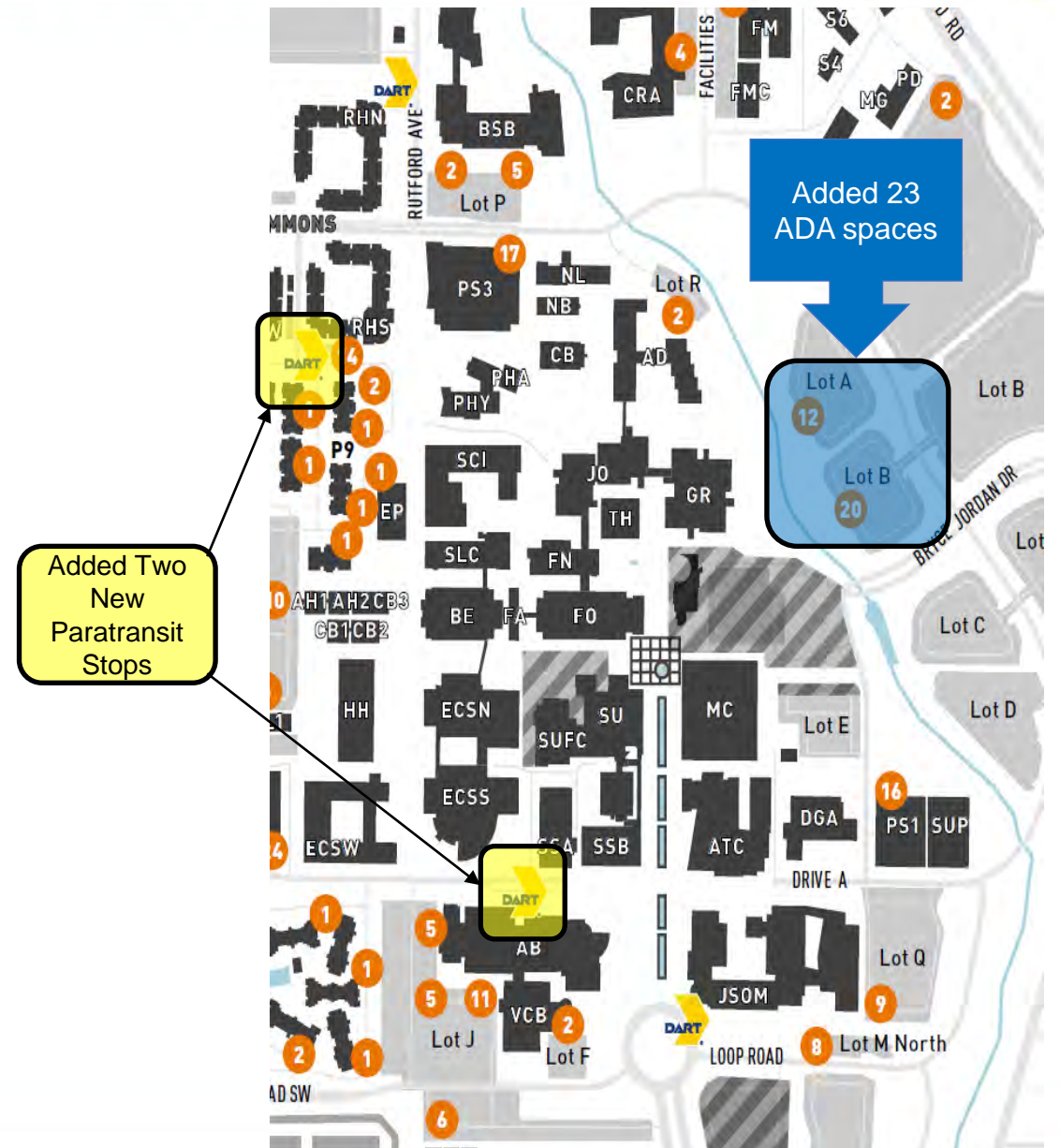
Parking & Transportation Updates

 - 2 in Lot V



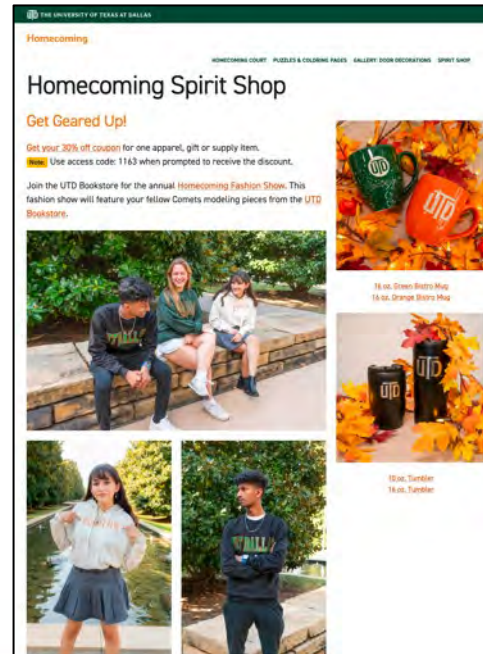
Accessible Parking During Construction

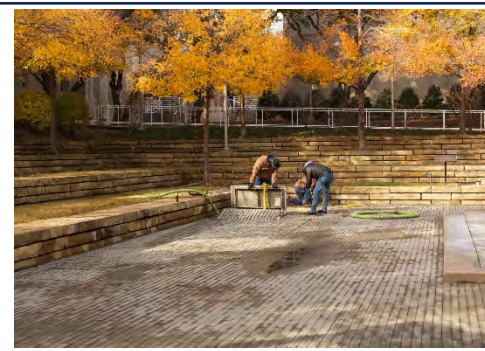

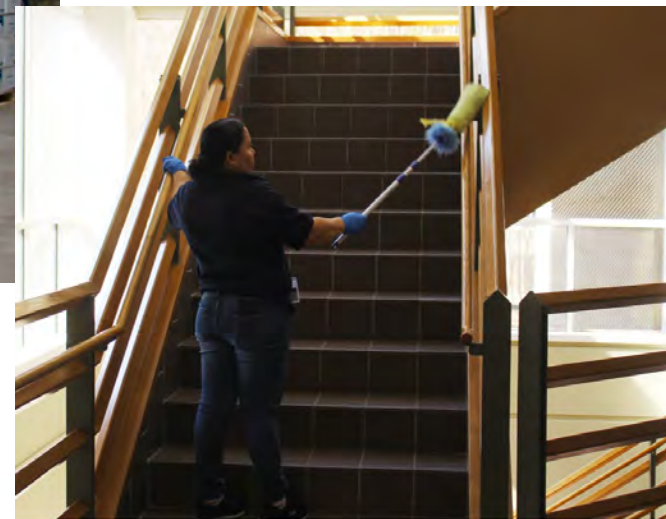

Fun Facts from Facilities Management

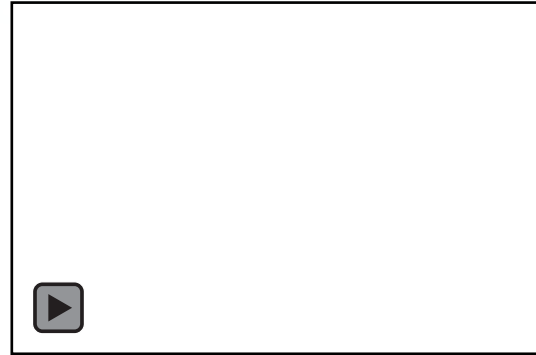
This past fiscal year (FY 23), our Facilities Management team:

- Processed **9,257** work orders
 - This past fall semester alone, FM has processed **3,415** work orders!!!
- Handled **1,258** moves and events
- Managed **1,046** custodial services requests
 - The UT Dallas campus community used:
 - **1,900** cases of toilet tissue (**22,800** jumbo rolls)
 - **3,230** cases of paper towels (**807,500** sheets)



Sustainability Accomplishments

- Recertification of UTD as a STARS Gold-rated campus.
- Climate Leadership Spotlight Series
- Sustainability Exemplars Panel
- Greenhouse installed at campus micro-farm
(partially funded by McDermott Scholars donation)
- By The Numbers:
 - **19** micro farm workdays (**300+** volunteers)
 - **120** bottles of Comet Honey sold
 - **21** Sustainability Service Honors graduates
 - **9** campus clean-ups hosted.
 - **5** new level 2 EV chargers installed on campus (with P&T)



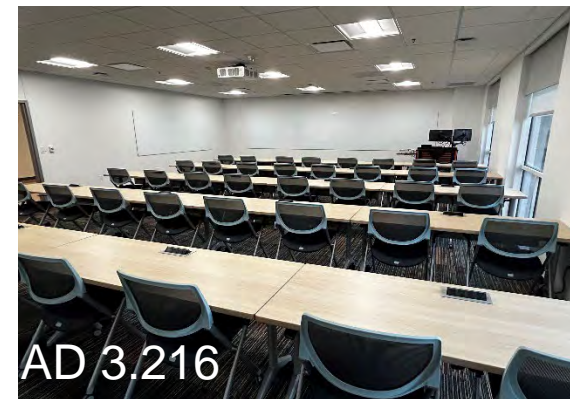
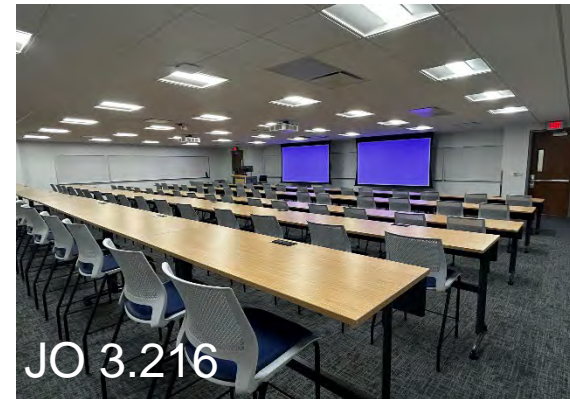
Engineering/Construction/Furniture Projects

- 62 completed projects

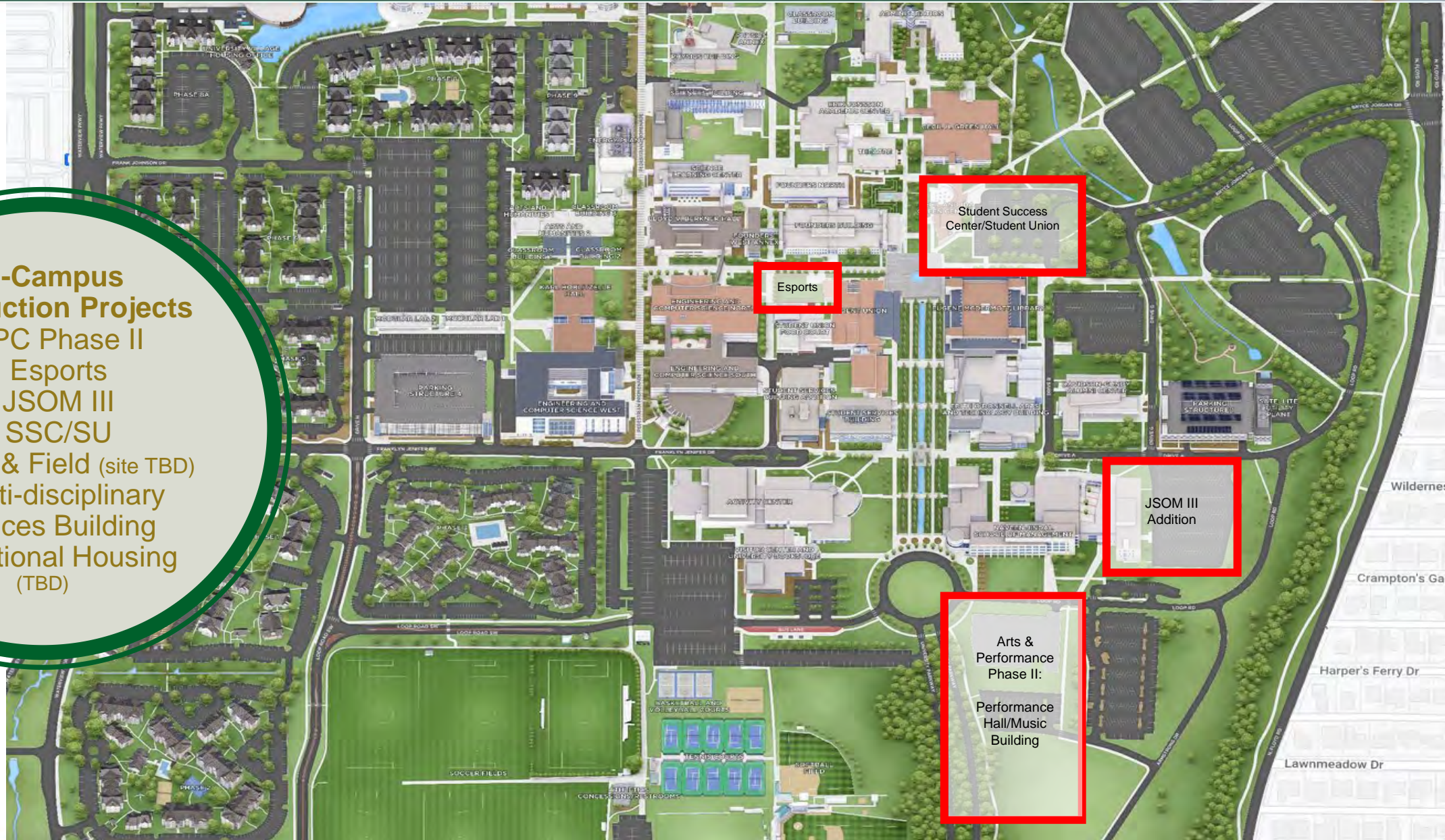

Athenaeum Construction Fun Facts

- The Athenaeum's freight elevator can carry up to **16,000 lbs.!**
 - *It's strong enough to lift three Tesla Model X electric vehicles.*
- The facility is constructed with:
 - **480** tons structural steel
That is the same as 74 elephants!
 - **4,203** cubic yards of concrete
Equal to 1.3 Olympic swimming pools

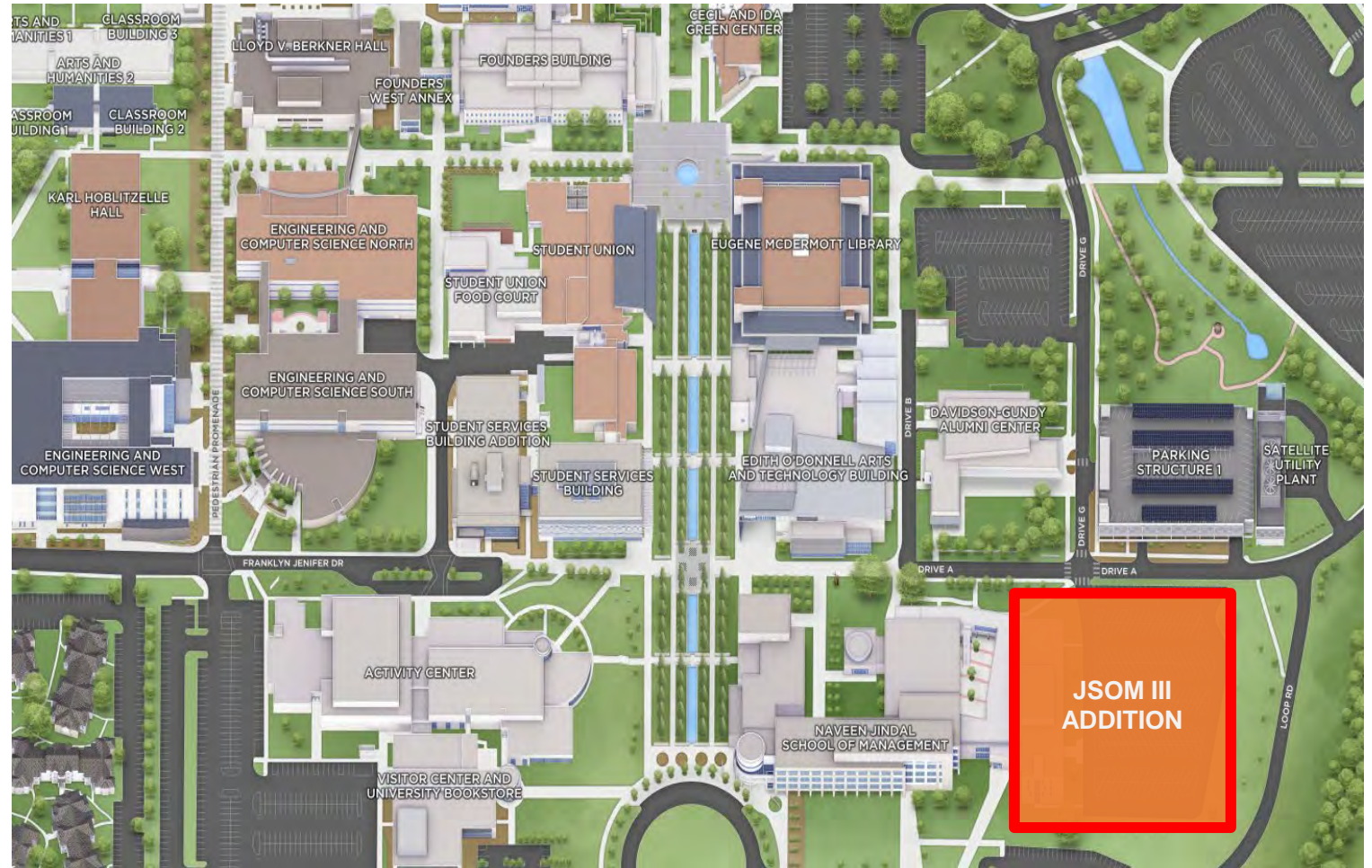

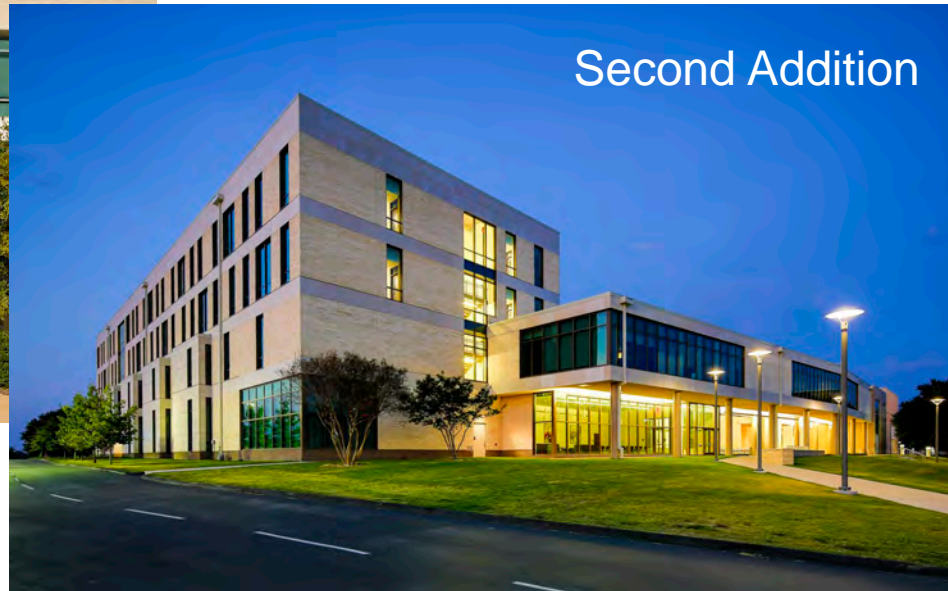

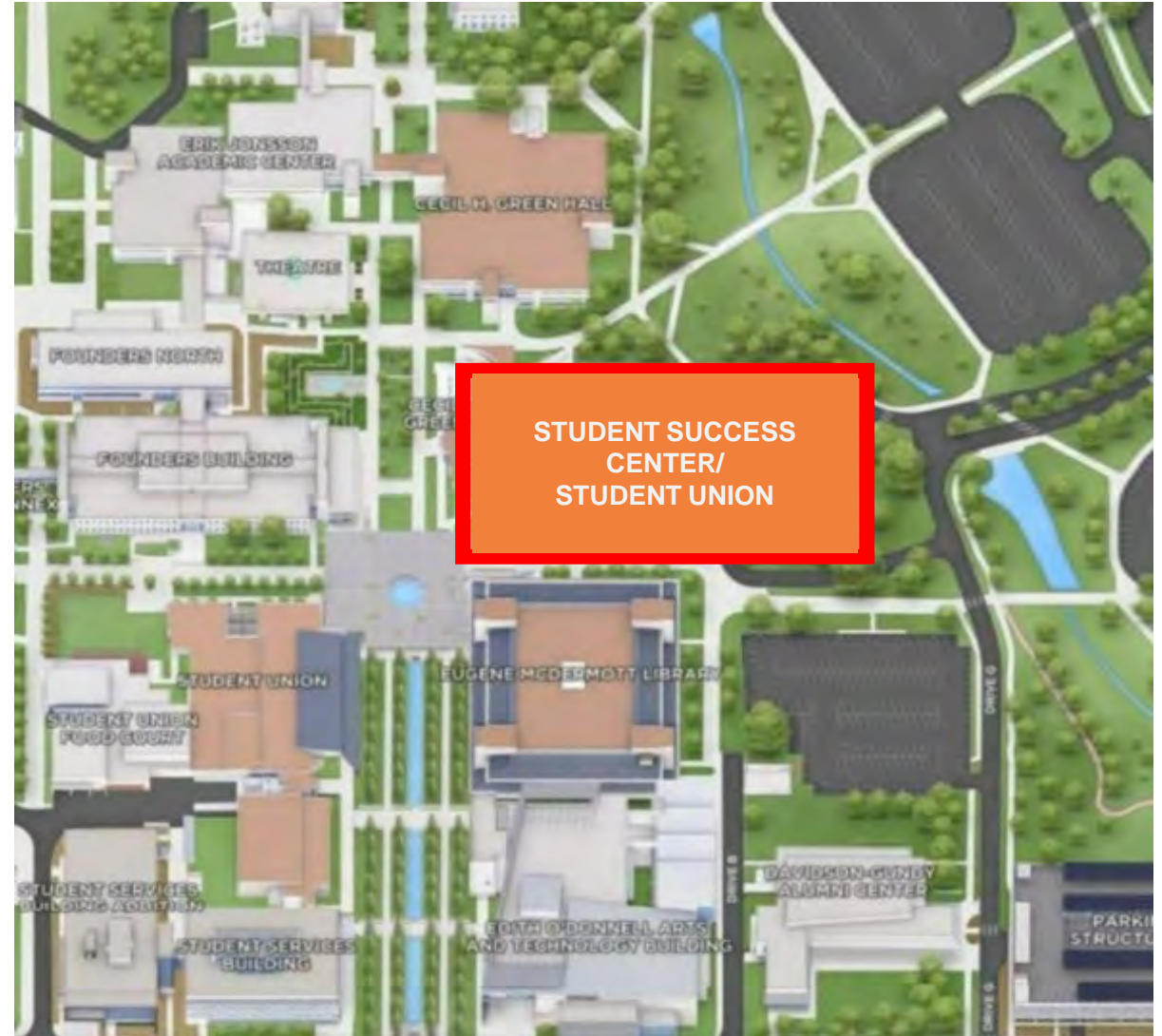

Multidisciplinary Science and Technology Building (MSTB)

Early plans are underway to design a multidisciplinary science and technology building to support the campus growth, as well as classroom and lab needs.



Destination 2025-26: DART Silver Line Station at UT Dallas

One of 10 stops on the DART Silver Line

Runs 26 miles from Shiloh Rd. in Plano to Terminal B in DFW Airport

Crosses seven North Texas cities

Connects to four light rail lines

Expected completion: Late 2025-Mid 2026



DART Silver Line Station at UT Dallas – Current Status

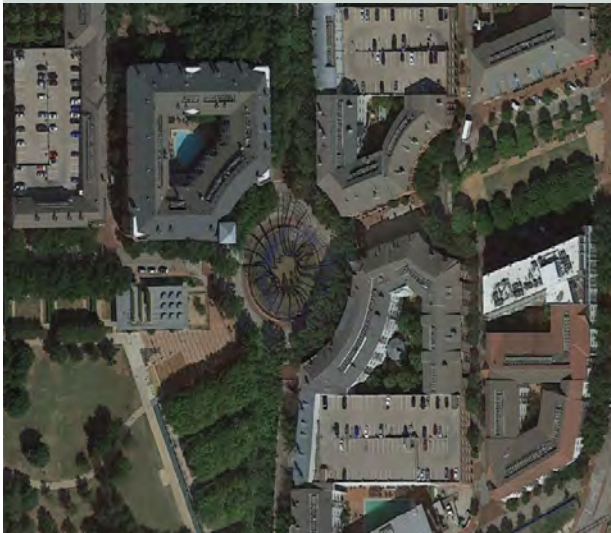
- One of 10 stops on the DART Silver Line

- Entertainment venues for surrounding communities



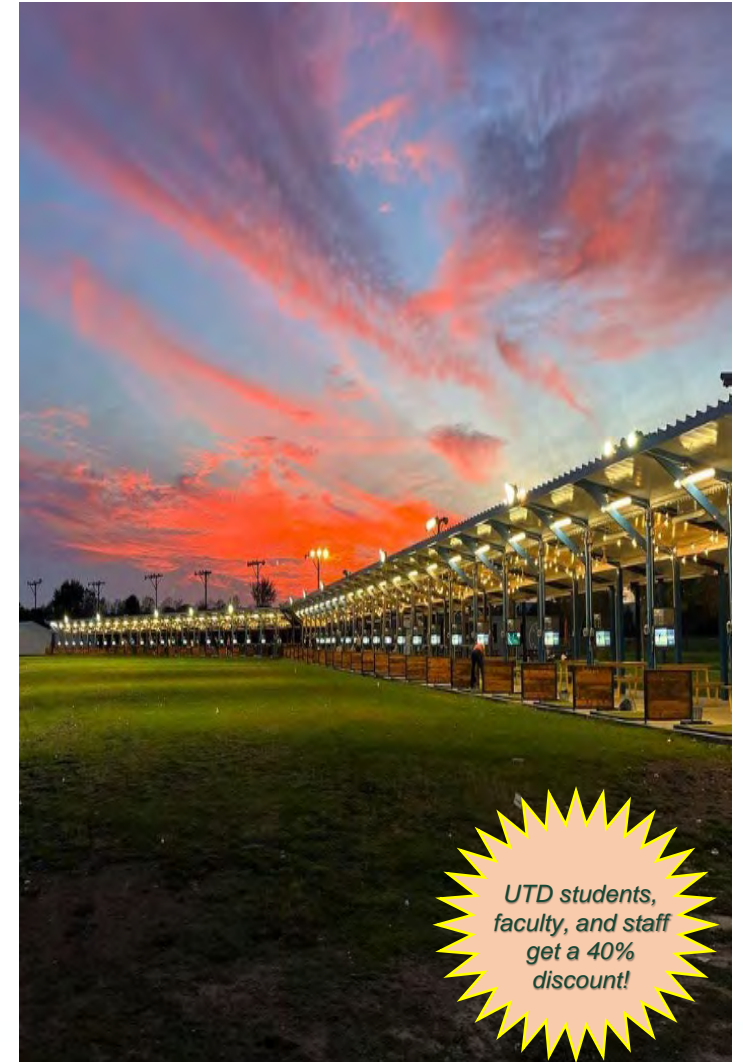
